Background At the meeting on 17 December 2015, the Panel determined to defer determining the

above development application, for the Panel to have further briefing from Traffic Engineers of the Council and the Applicant. This was in response to concerns raised by adjoining residents on the carriage capacity of Hannah Street and its suitability to carry the additional traffic for the proposed development. No vehicular access is

proposed from Great Western Highway.

Briefing On 17 February 2016, the Panel was briefed by Roy El Kazzi, Council's Traffic

Engineer and Robert Varga, Applicant's Traffic Engineer. The traffic experts provided a commentary on the carriage capacity of Hannah Street and answered

questions raised by the Panel.

Following the briefing; the Panel declared their satisfaction on the carriage capacity of Hannah Street to support additional traffic movement from the proposed

development.
