MATTER DETERMINED

2016STH014 – Yass Valley – DA5.2016.57.1 – Extending the operational life of the Bogo Quarry for 30 years including: increase in the approved production level of hard rock products; importation, placement and operation of mobile concrete and asphalt plants and construction of a southern earth bund and to plant a perimeter tree screen – Lot 1 DP 1205646, 134 Paynes Road, Bookham (AS DESCRIBED IN SCHEDULE 1)

PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION
