MATTER DEFERRED

2016SYW072 - Blacktown - JRPP-16-03305 - Mixed Use Development - Lots 96, 97, 98 & 99 DP 11157, No. 9-17 Second Avenue, Blacktown (AS DESCRIBED IN SCHEDULE 1)

PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

The Panel considered: the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at meetings and the matters observed at site inspections listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

The Panel determined to defer the development application as described in Schedule 1 pursuant to section 80 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The decision was unanimous.

REASONS FOR THE DEFERRAL

The reasons for the decision of the Panel were:

- 1. The Panel notes the application seeks a 7.2% variation (up to four metres) of the building height standard and that there is a requirement for a detailed flood study to be undertaken. The latter could add further to the building height.
 - The Panel requires the flood study to be completed and the final building height determined. A revised Clause 4.6 variation request may be needed at that time.
- 2. The Panel also requires submission of an additional plan which clearly shows the relationship between Stages 1 and 2, and specifically the shadowing impacts on the communal open space identified on plan DAL101 29/2/16.
- 3. The Panel notes the assessment report does not adequately address the requirements of Clause 7, SEPP 55 Remediation of Land and requires that a site investigation report be provided that addresses all the relevant requirements of the SEPP.

Once this information has been received and a supplementary report has been provided from the Council the Panel will seek to determine this matter electronically.
