




MATTER DEFERRED

2016WES013 – Murray River – DA033/17 - RAN 79 Rushy Road, Moama – Extractive Industry - Extension of area of existing sandpit and increase in extraction volume.

REASONS FOR DEFERRAL

The panel agreed to defer the determination of the matter pending the preparation of an assessment report by the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) that evaluates the proposed development pursuant to section 4.15 of the EP&A Act by building upon the assessment report prepared by the Council. The further evaluation will ensure that an appropriate level of rigour is applied to the assessment, conclusion and recommendations of the report. DPIE’s work will be undertaken expeditiously with the view to the assessment report being completed no later than 7 December, enabling the panel to reconvene on 14 December to determine the development application

The decision to defer the matter was unanimous.
