2016WES016 – Dubbo Regional Council – D16-482 – 20L Sheraton Road Dubbo NSW – Extractive Industry (Quarry). Establishment of an open cut basalt quarry and associated infrastructure. Quarry would have a production of up to 250,000 tonnes per annum for a period of up to 30 years. Quarry footprint approximately 24 hectares with a depth ranging from 12m to 15m. All production activities such as crushing, screening etc. to occur on site.

The legal advice is required to enable the Panel to establish whether the proposed development is permissible with development consent.

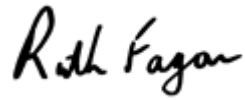
When this information has been received, the panel will hold another public determination meeting.
