**Proposed Resource Recovery Facility – Gormans Hill NSW (DA 2016/413)**

I refer to your request dated 29 November 2016 seeking comment from the Office of Environment and Heritage (OEH) on the exhibited Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the proposed Resource Recovery Facility in Gormans Hill, NSW.

OEH has responsibilities under the:

- *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974* - namely the protection and care of Aboriginal objects and places, the protection and care of native flora and fauna and the protection and management of reserves;
- *Threatened Species Conservation Act 1995* - which aims to conserve threatened species of flora and fauna, populations and ecological communities to promote their recovery and manage processes that threaten them; and the
- *Native Vegetation Conservation Act 2003* – ensuring compliance with the requirements of this legislation.

Based on the information provided, OEH has no specific comments to make on the proposed Resource Recovery Centre at this stage. We assume that the proposal has adequately considered the requirements under the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* of OEH areas of responsibility (i.e. natural and cultural heritage conservation issues). Please note that if subsequent information indicates that these areas within OEH's responsibility require further investigation, OEH may provide future input.
