Thank you for meeting with Transport for NSW (TfNSW) on 28 March 2019 to discuss the subject development located within the broad area under investigation for the Lower Hunter Freight Corridor (LHFC) between Fassifern and Hexham.

As previously mentioned in correspondence dated 08/02/2018 (Ref: CD19/00147), the future LHFC has the potential to impact the eastern boundary of the Wakefield Site (the Site). As such, following a review of the updated plans submitted to the Regional Planning Panel (the Panel), Transport for NSW remains concerned that the proposed accommodation and the layout of the racetrack may impact on a future LHFC.

Transport for NSW is willing to work with Council and the applicant to minimise future impacts on the LHFC corridor and it is recommended that the Panel impose a condition of consent requiring staged development and further consultation with Transport for NSW regarding any development along the eastern edge of the site.
