






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








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


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









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Floor Plan	Dimensions	East	End


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
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



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










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




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








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## **OVERALL LANDSCAPE INTENT**

The design aims to create a simple yet stylish character that can be carried through the entire site to enhance the gateway experience of the overall development. All proposed treatments and elements will be designed to be robust and responsive to the Ballina climate and context. Through the use of hardscape and softscape landscape elements the visitor experience shall be enhanced in all areas. The plaza and drop off spaces will be the focus of detailed design. These areas aim to enhance legibility while creating an inviting arrival and departure experience.

### **Entrance Drop Off & The Plaza**

The drop off zone has been designed to create a spacious area with an introduction to the development design theme though the use of planting and feature furniture. The pathway treatments aim to create easy navigation and way-finding for pedestrians into the plaza space and building entrances.

Feature angular raised turf/planting platforms provide green breaks in the large hardscaped space. Planting areas have the opportunity to use local endemic species to promote local bio-diversity while reducing water usage and maintenance.

Seating and lighting elements can be incorporated into the design of the platforms or be standalone items. There is an opportunity to incorporate this element within the internal airport design where space allows.

By providing areas with flexible uses the space can used as required. There is potential for the turf platforms to double as play areas or event spaces.

The existing Leopard Trees will be treated as a feature which will help to enhance the scale and feel of the large space while retaining the local character and feel of Ballina.

The plaza theme and treatments are to be carried through the future stages of the development allowing a clear continuation of pathways to other services (taxi and bus).


# **Existing & Proposed Carpark/Streetscape**

There is potential to upgrade the existing entry roads and garden beds to improve legibility and overall design continuity. With the continuation of hardscape and softscape elements the development theme will be felt throughout the entire site.

Through the use of character trees (Leopard tree) and native species, development banners and an entry statement, the entry roads would be transformed into a formal entrance avenue.

#### **External Roundabout & Roadworks**

To enhance the experience of departure and arrival a continuation of internal planting palettes and hardscape treatments is recommended. These works will help to project the desired character and image sought for the airport precinct.












FEATURE ANGULAR RAISED TURF/PLANTING BEDS WITH SEATING/LIGHTING.

#### **AREA 03: FEATURE ENTRANCE**

INTRODUCTION OF PLANTING CHARACTER AND THEME.

POTENTIAL TO INCORPORATE DEVELOPMENT BANNERS AND TREE PLANTINGS TO CREATE AN ENTRANCE AVENUE.

POTENTIAL TO INCORPORATE ENTRY STATEMENT ON ENTRY ROADS.

#### AREA 04: TAXI & BUS

CONTINUATION OF DEVELOPMENT THEME AND CONTRASTING PAVEMENT TO ALLOW CLEAR PATHWAYS TO SERVICES.

#### **AREA 05: CAR PARK**

CONTINUATION OF DEVELOPMENT HARDSCAPE AND SOFTSCAPES. POTENTIAL TO ENHANCE EXISTING GARDEN BEDS TO MATCH UPGRADE WORKS.

#### AREA: EXTERNAL WORKS ENTRY PLANTING
