Public meeting held at Port Macquarie-Hastings Council Corner Lord and Burrawan Streets Port Macquarie on 8 March 2018, opened at 10.30am and closed at 11.30am.

MATTER DETERMINED

2017NTH031 – Port Macquarie-Hastings – DA2017/1045.1 at 14 Highfield Circuit Port Macquarie (AS DESCRIBED IN SCHEDULE 1)

PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

The Panel considered: the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at meetings and the matters observed at site inspections listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

The Panel determined to approve the development application as described in Schedule 1 pursuant to section 4.16 (previously section 80) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The decision was unanimous.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The reasons for the decision of the Panel were:

- The proposed development is permissible in the zoning and satisfies all relevant SEPP's and the Port Macquarie-Hastings LEP 2011;
- The proposal was amended to increase setback to the western side to a minimum 1.3m to provide additional amenity to the western neighbour;
- Health services facilities in this part of Port Macquarie are supported in the North Coast Regional Plan 2036; and
- The Panel was satisfied that the proposed development will be constructed to comply with the requirements of the EPA regulations regarding potential for radiation levels arising from operation of the facility.

CONDITIONS

The development application was approved subject to the conditions in the Council Assessment Report with the following amendments.

• Condition A (1) was amended to add the Landscape plan to the schedule of supporting documents
