68-72 Railway Parade & 2-10 Oxford Street, Burwood

Mixed Use Development - Construction of an 8-storey building for a mixed use development containing shop-top housing above 3 ground floor retail shops and a residential flat building consisting of 121 residential apartments all above basement parking

REASONS FOR DEFERRAL

During the meeting the applicant tabled diagrams showing the shadow impact of the development on the adjoining school. The council's assessment planner indicated that he had not seen these diagrams before. Moreover, the tabled diagrams show the shadows for 10 am, noon, 1, 2 and 3 pm, but not for 10 and 11 am.

The diagrams should be amended to also show shadows for these times, as well as indicate grassed and paved areas of the school. Finally, the diagrams should also indicate the shadow that would be cast by the approved DA 74/2015.

Accordingly, the Panel requests the applicant to provide, by 13 July 2018, shadow diagrams as indicated above. The Panel requests the council planner to provide the diagrams to the representative of the school's P&C, and to provide a supplementary report to the Panel by 27 July 2018.

Following receipt of the supplementary report the Panel will convene another public meeting.

The decision to defer the matter was unanimous.

The Panel adjourned during the meeting to deliberate on the matter and formulate a resolution.
