PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

The Panel considered: the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at meetings and the matters observed at site inspections listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

The Panel determined to refuse the development application as described in Schedule 1 pursuant to section 80 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The Panel adjourned during the meeting to deliberate on the matter and formulate a resolution.

The decision was unanimous.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The Panel supports the recommendation for refusal by the Council, for the following reasons:

- The Rural Fire Service (RFS) has not provided its general terms of approval. Further, even if the RFS requirements were able to be met on the site, the impact on the ecology and habitat are likely to be significant, and insufficient information was provided to allow for a determination.
- Adverse impacts on the creek.
- Adverse impacts on the ecology of the area.
- Dramatic changes to the landform.
