# MATTER DETERMINED

2017SNH048 – Hornsby – DA1270/16 at 6 & 8 Laughtondale Gully Road and 4835, 4843, 4847 & 47777 Old Northern Road Maroota (AS DESCRIBED IN SCHEDULE 1)

# PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

The Panel considered: the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at meetings and the matters observed at site inspections listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

The Panel adjourned during the meeting to deliberate on the matter and formulate a resolution.

The Panel determined to approve the development application as described in Schedule 1 pursuant to section 4.16 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The decision was unanimous.

# **REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

In accepting the assessment report's recommendation to approve the application, the Panel has clarified and added to the conditions of consent. The applicant has agreed to these changes. The reasons for the decision of the Panel were:

- The proposed quarry provides for a much-needed resource.
- The proposal minimises the environmental impact of the operation.
- Where environmental impacts cannot be avoided, the proposal compensates for them by providing for vegetation offsets on site.

# CONDITIONS

The development application was approved subject to the conditions in the Council Assessment Report with the following amendments:

- New condition 18A) to read as follows: Details of noise bunds along the western side boundary of the extraction area be detailed on plans submitted to Council prior to the Construction Certificate.
- The following is added to Condition 43: Noise bunds are to be constructed along the western side boundary of the extraction area using excavated top soil.

Condition 1a) is amended by adding "to Council" after "submitted" and by adding at the end a new sentence "In preparation of the detailed plans, the applicant shall consider any impact on historical relics."

The section at the beginning of the conditions called "General Conditions" shall be moved to after Condition 1.
