PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

The Panel considered: the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at meetings and the matters observed at site inspections listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

The Panel determined to approve the development application as described in Schedule 1 pursuant to section 80 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The Panel adjourned during the meeting to deliberate on the matter and formulate a resolution.

The decision was unanimous.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The reasons for the decision of the Panel were:

- The proposal responds to an important need in the locality to accommodate more children in the school.
- The proposal removes demountable classrooms and replaces them with permanent ones.
- The impacts of the proposal on the surrounding area are acceptable.

CONDITIONS

The development application was approved subject to the conditions in the Council Assessment Report except as follows:

- 1. Condition 2, 17, 63 and 64 are deleted.
- 2. In all conditions that refer to "Construction Certificate" that word is replaced by "Crown Certificate".

- 3. In all conditions that refer to "Occupation Certificate" that word is replaced by "Completion Certificate".
- 4. Condition 77 is amended by replacing the last sentence with "No work is to resume to the impacted heritage item until the written approval of council is obtained."
