

The planting in the Community Terrace Garden sets the planting style for the apartments, driven by the micro climate considerations and a requirement for a memorable first impression. The garden features contrasting forms and foliage textures, layered to display a cohesive evergreen effect, planting without complex expensive maintenance but of significant visual impact. Bold Simple..Native Evergreen Tree structure, tree accent...shady ferery accent garden, massed mono specie groundcovers, feature plants for seasonal variety and interest, Magnolia souleangiana for seasonal with massed Algerian lvy ,Hedera canariensis & Flax Lily Dianell tasmanica under.... Lily Pilly Syzigiuim spp for privacy to courtyards




