Public meeting held at Fairfield City Council on Friday, 15 December 2017, opened at 3:00 pm and closed at 3:35 pm.

MATTER DETERMINED

2017SSW047 – Fairfield – 266.1/2017 AT 29 Chifley Street, Smithfield (AS DESCRIBED IN SCHEDULE 1)

PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

The Panel considered: the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at meetings and the matters observed at site inspections listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

The Panel determined to approve the development application as described in Schedule 1 pursuant to section 80 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The decision was unanimous.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The reasons for the decision of the Panel were:

- 1. The proposed development will provide specialist waste management and resource recovery facilities to the Sydney Western District.
- 2. The proposed development adequately satisfies the relevant State Environmental Planning Policies, including State Environmental Planning Policy No 55 Remediation of Land, State Environmental Planning Policy (Infrastructure) 2007 and Greater Metropolitan Regional Environmental Plan No 2 Georges River Catchment.
- 3. The proposal adequately satisfies the applicable provisions and objectives of Fairfield Local Environment Plan 2013 and Fairfield Citywide Development Control Plan 2013.
- 4. The proposed development, subject to the conditions imposed will have no unacceptable adverse impacts on the natural or built environments including the riparian systems, the operation of the local road system or premises in the locality.
- 5. In consideration of conclusions 1-4 above the Panel considers the proposed development is a suitable use of the site and approval of the proposal is in the public interest.

CONDITIONS

The development application was approved subject to the conditions in the Council Assessment Report with the following amendments.

- Condition 10 to be amended to read as follows:
 - 10. Stormwater Isolation Valve and NSW Fire Brigade Notification
 - 1. Prior to the issue of an Occupation Certificate (Interim or Final), evidence is to be provided to the Principal Certifying Authority and Fairfield City Council, that the stormwater system that the premises utilises includes a stormwater isolation valve.

- 2. Prior to the issue of an Occupation Certificate (Interim or Final), evidence is to be provided to the Principal Certifying Authority and Fairfield City Council that the NSW Fire Brigade has been notified of the exact location and operational procedures of the stormwater isolation valve(s).
- Condition 9 to be amended to remove the reference to the Construction Certificate, so that the wording of the first sentence begins "Prior to the issue of an Occupation Certificate".
