KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Activation of streets required, especially Soldiers Parade and Henderson Road
- Whole development to function as a 'place' not a shopping centre

Planning Panels Secretariat

- Applicant to clearly demonstrate how the street uses provide social interaction
- Design, over shadowing of Residential Precinct 1, COS areas and Childcare centre
- Stairs to Eat Street from Soldiers Parade, physical edge and accessibility
- Relocation of waste management from Basement level 2 to Basement 1
- Public Laneway to RFB's B06 and B07 requires activation/ treatment
- Compliance with concept plans as modified
- Compliance with ADG required, COS to comply, max number of units off circulation core
- Compliance with all associated plans and design guides applicable to the site
- Critical services provision to be confirmed before determination
- Close examination of the active areas especially street frontages, so large commercial tenancies do not inhabit social interaction within the town centre
- Confirmation of SIC Levy requirements
- Council resolution for John Edmondson Memorial to be included in Town Centre Core
- · Conflict between retail and residential parking
- Consideration of deep soil areas
- DEP to consider Panel comments
