Re: Proposed Relocation of Site Trees to new location on this site - Letter of Confirmation  
Proposed Residential Apartments - 55-61 Newtown Road, Blacktown

Dear Richard,

This letter is provided following our investigation of the three site trees on the subject sites (4 combined lots), and enquiry as to whether they could be successfully relocated from their existing positions towards the middle rear of the site, to the Newton Road front boundary where deep soil is to be retained.

We note there are two small exotic trees at 3-4 metres height and a Lilly Pilly tree approximately 6m high x 6m diameter canopy.

From experience on previous projects we confirm we believe transplanting these trees to relocate to the proposed 'deep soil' zone along the Newton Road frontage of the site is very straight forward, and establishment maintenance would be part of the process of acclimatising to the new site location. We have sought independent professional confirmation of our assessment of the suitability of these specific trees through contacting Lauren Hickson (who works with Peter Wild, GM of Transplant Industries (Tree Transplant Specialist Consultants and Contractors)). We note we have worked with them on a number occasions to relocate trees on other projects, with them being industry leaders in this field.

We confirm discussions with Lauren that confirmed there would be no problem with completing the transplanting to the Newton Road frontage. They are in the process of providing a firm quotation for these works, and it is the project intention to engage this firm (or similar expert firm) to complete the works.
