

Appendix F - Planting Design

Planting design is to provide a mix of endemic, native and exotic in approximate proportions of 30%, 40% and 30%. The aim is to create a strong natural character to all perimeters, with integration of exotic and native species to the internal site areas to provide seasonality and garden qualities appropriate to retirement living.

The species of the main structural tree planting are generally shown on the adjacent plan to reflect the principles as noted above. Detailed shrub, groundcover and grasses planting will be provided at CC stage to be consistent with the % mix as noted above.

Key tree species are listed below, being a mix of existing trees occurring on the golf course and existing site, local endemic species, and exotic trees for colour and flowering and for their deciduous character to allow winter sun access to open space.
