### **KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED**

- The important relationship of the proposed nil setback to the property boundaries at the north east corner noting that part of the northern boundary is to a detached house which may be isolated from substantial future commercial development.
- Importance of ensuring a resolved presentation to Sommerset Street of the development enabling a good relationship with future development to the north.

- Landscaping presentation to streets, street tree planting, western elevation, proposed built form and colours
- Benefit for an overstreet awning having regard to the DCP.
- Provide acceptable articulation and visual interest to the surrounding locality particularly to the important corner of Sommerset and Derby Street.
- Consideration should be given to increasing the café size to activate the ground level relationship and allow for a viable business.
- Architectural presentation of the northern end of the western elevation (currently a grey square with irregular window arrangement.
