#### **MATTER DETERMINED**

2018ECI013 – Inner West – DA2018/450 - Off 48 Fitzroy Avenue Balmain – Dawn Fraser Baths (as described in Schedule 1)

#### PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

The Panel considered: the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at meetings and briefings and the matters observed at site inspections listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

The Panel adjourned during the meeting to deliberate on the matter and formulate a resolution.

The Panel determined to approve the development application pursuant to section 4.16 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The decision was unanimous.

#### **REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

The proposed upgrade and refurbishment of the Dawn Fraser Pool are essential to the continued existence and functioning of an important heritage item, which is also a much-loved community facility.

# **CONDITIONS**

The development application was approved subject to the conditions in the Council Assessment Report with the following amendments:

- The deletion of prescribed Condition A (BASIX Commitments)
- The deletion of prescribed Condition C (Home Building Act)

These conditions are deleted because they do not apply.

### **CONSIDERATION OF COMMUNITY VIEWS**

In coming to its decision, the Panel considered written submissions made during public exhibition and heard from two objectors at the public meeting. The Panel noted that the objectors' concerns related to bigger change rooms, more showers and a different design for the entrance. While the Panel appreciates the concerns of the objectors, it considers that it cannot involve itself in the detailed architectural design of a State heritage item, on which opinions vary widely. It therefore accepts the proposal before it as a legitimate response to the need to retain the Dawn Fraser Pool.
