

6.0 PROPOSAL NORTH FACADE SECTION











6.0 PROPOSAL NORTH FACADE PLAN








6.0 PROPOSAL EAST/WEST FACADE



"The imposing Hunter Street building was once the headquarters of the Newcastle and Suburban Co-operative Society Ltd, more popularly known as The Store.




