2018SCL026 – Randwick - DA/132/2017/C AT 30-36 Dangar Street Randwick (AS DESCRIBED IN SCHEDULE 1)

PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

The Panel considered: the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at meetings and the matters observed at site inspections listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

The Panel determined to approve the development application as described in Schedule 1 pursuant to section 4.55 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The decision was unanimous.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The reasons for the decision of the Panel were:

- The modified proposal is substantially the same as the original proposal.
- The modifications sought and approved do not have any material additional environmental or amenity impacts.
- The Panel has not approved that part of the amendment application which refers to "modification to landscaping for detention area R1A", for which the necessary information was not submitted to council until four days before this public meeting and has not been advertised. The applicant is advised to submit a separate section 4.55(2) application for these works.

CONDITIONS

The development application was approved subject to the conditions in the Council Assessment Report with the addition of the following condition:

• "The consent does not include approval of the modification to landscaping for detention area R1A due to enlarged basin based on engineering requirements."
