#### **KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED**

Assessment of the adequacy, efficiency and safety of proposed pedestrian links is warranted. The proximity of the shops is the main advantage of this site for higher development, but the absence of a means to efficiently walk to those shops undermines that advantage.

The proposal might also benefit from consideration of the layout of the development to think through ways it might better relate to its surroundings. For example, the design might make the piazza more functional by incorporating it in a practical pedestrian route or destination. Planning for compatibility with neighbouring development at the El Cabalo Blanco site might also assist.

Consideration of the overlap of the proposed APZs and the backyards is needed.
