2018STH011 – Wagga Wagga – DA14/0448.01 at Cooramin St, Cartwrights Hill (AS DESCRIBED IN SCHEDULE 1)

REASONS FOR DEFERRAL

The Panel considered: the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at meetings and the matters observed at site inspections listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

The Panel adjourned during the meeting to deliberate on the matter and formulate a resolution.

The Panel determined to defer the modification application as described in Schedule 1 pursuant to section 4.55 (previously section 96) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The decision was Unanimous.

The reasons for the decision of the Panel were:

- 1. To allow for a revised set of conditions to be provided that are consistent with the original conditions conveyed in the notice of determination dated 11 November 2015 and include amendments to these conditions recommended under this application to modify a consent.
- 2. To allow a further report to be circulated to the Panel identifying the changes to conditions referred to in point 1.

The Panel notes the following changes which are to be included in the revised set of conditions:

- Delete part (i) of Condition 21A, to allow for a 1.2 metre fence around the track).
- Condition 85 to be reviewed to restrict the number of events that are permitted to exceed the adopted noise criteria.
- That condition 53 be amended to include a requirement that the event noise management plan be reviewed annually

Once this information has been received, the Panel will determine the matter electronically.
