KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED

- No parking on site supported
- Roof removal noted
- State heritage item
- Heritage item to be brought before the Heritage Council meeting May 2018 GTAs unknown
- DEAP said not well considered noted that it doesn't meet usual standards of concept application
- Internally not happy for Council architects Crestani/McReddie
- No design competition as yet perhaps unnecessary? Latest Court judgement says so.
- Must do design comp first.
- Significant issue for application design competition is usually first, but this scheme is key for development and leaves little scope.
- No legal access through Horwood Place as it is not a public road Council owns the land. No right-ofways.
- Council as owner needs to respond.
- Safety issues supporting the structure and keeping the ceiling of the theatre.
- Panel supports Council approach for the design excellence competition first
- Not imminent issues not revolved no response from Heritage Council yet.
