## KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED AND MATTERS TO BE IN THE COUNCIL ASSESSMENT REPORT

- 1. Separation from and juxtaposition with potential future building on the site to the north of the subject land is an important matter requiring consideration and attention from the Design Review Panel (to which the DA should be referred).
- 2. If the development application is approved signage on the building should be conditioned to ensure it is not visually intrusive.
- 3. The response arising from the RMS referral should be considered in relation to potential impacts on the affected intersections.
- 4. Whether the design needs to allow for pedestrian connectivity.
