**KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED AND MATTERS TO BE IN THE COUNCIL ASSESSMENT REPORT**

1. Impacts on local neighbours in terms of odour and acoustics are to be considered carefully.
2. The effects of mitigating measures to address these impacts are to be taken into account.
3. Given the importance of the ability of the site to absorb the proposed effluent without environmental and amenity impacts, Council should ensure that the applicant’s design report is considered by an appropriately qualified person (whether that is an engineer on Council staff or an independent consultant).
4. The visual impacts of the proposed acoustic mounds, associated tree removal, and whether the mounds should be vegetated should be considered.
