**DA2018/41: Waste Management Facility; Lots 7008 & 7009 DP 1020396; Daroobalgie Road, Daroobalgie**

Thank you for letter referring DA2018/41 - *Statement of Environmental Effects* (SoEE) for the Waste Depot Expansion dated 05 October 2018 to Roads and Maritime Services for comment. I note DA2018/41 has been referred to Roads and Maritime in accordance with clause 104 of the *State Environmental Planning Policy (Infrastructure) 2007*.

The documentation submitted in support of DA2018/41 has been reviewed and Roads and Maritime notes the proposal includes:

- Lateral expansion (development footprint) extension into part of Lot 1472 DP 750158 and Lot 1 DP 120710.
- No changes to the nature, scale or hours of operation of authorised activities undertaken at the facility.
- Closing the existing landfill and opening a new landfill on the same lot of land.
- No change to existing traffic volumes or movements.
- A new site entrance (located at the existing location) designed to meet intersection requirements specified under *Austroads Guide to Road Design*.
- Construction of a waste receiver station, including a weighbridge and designated separation areas for waste.
- Site office and associated amenities and car parking.
- Un-tarpping area.
- A community recycling area.

**Roads and Maritime Services**

- A resource recovery centre/shop.
- Sealed road network (one way traffic flow).

Pursuant to Clause 104 of the *State Environmental Planning Policy (Infrastructure) 2007*, Roads and Maritime does not object to the proposed development and makes no comment.
