KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED AND MATTERS TO BE IN THE COUNCIL ASSESSMENT REPORT:

- Visible impacts
- Landscaping
- View lines
- Way finding issues
- Proximity to Prospect Reservoir

- Geotechnical report impact on ground water and impact of filling on the ground water and the risk of aquifer forming between the existing and filled ground level
- Ground water Hydrologist
- Detailed Hydrological report surveying conditions
- Importation of fill truck movements per day during construction
- Management of ground water issues and implementation, Hydrological report is required
- Significant volumes of fill are required to meet engineering requirements
- Heritage item any refurbishment of church?
- Any requirement for a function centre at the site?
- Treatment of site for screen landscaping to council's satisfaction
- Consultation with OEH is required
- The land is in the SEPP Sydney Drinking water catchment 2011 and the UPRCT area so consultation is required
