MATTER DEFERRED

2019ECI019 – Waverley – DA125/2012/B at 20 Illawong Avenue, Tamara for modifications to an approved application (as described in Schedule 1)

REASONS FOR DEFERRAL

The Panel received a written request from the applicant to defer the application. The applicant indicated that it no longer wished to construct an additional level of parking; instead it wished to amend the application to increase the number of parking spaces within the ground and basement areas already approved for parking. The extent of the increase would be substantially less than in the current modification application. The council's assessment officer did not oppose the request to defer the application.

For these reasons the Panel agreed to defer the determination of the application.

The Panel requests the applicant to lodge amended plans by 30 August 2019 and the assessment officer to prepare a supplementary assessment by 13 September 2019. After receipt of the supplementary report, the Panel will determine the application at a further public meeting.

The decision to defer the matter was unanimous.
