PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

By circulation of papers the Panel considered: the material listed at item 5 of Schedule 1 and the matters raised and/or observed at briefings and site inspections listed at item 6 in Schedule 1.

Based on this information, the Panel determined:

- to issue a site compatibility certificate subject to satisfaction of certain requirements (as listed below), because the application has demonstrated that the site is suitable for more intensive development and it is compatible with the surrounding environment.
- to refuse to issue a site compatibility certificate, because the application:

kas not demonstrated that the site is suitable for more intensive development

A has not demonstrated the proposed development is compatible with the surrounding

environment and land uses having regard to (at least) the criteria specified in clause 25(5)(b) of SEPP (Housing for Seniors or People with a Disability) 2004.

The Panel authorises the Chair to notify the applicant, Council and the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment of the Panel's decision to refuse the application.

The decision was unanimous.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

- 1. The Panel is not satisfied that the proposed development is compatible with surrounding land uses given the potential adverse impacts on the natural environment, particularly the loss of vegetation and visual impact arising from the intensity of the development.
- 2. The proposed siting, built form and landscape outcomes result in a character of development that is inconsistent and incompatible with the existing and future land uses in the surrounding locality.

- 3. The proposal has not demonstrated that there are adequate services available to meet the demands arising from the development.
- 4. The location of the site and more intense form of development is inconsistent with the evolving settlement pattern for the surrounding area.
