MATTER DETERMINED

2019NTH013 – Coffs Harbour City Council – 0742/19DA – educational facility - 421 Hogbin Drive COFFS HARBOUR (as described in Schedule 1)

PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

The panel considered: the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at meetings and briefings and the matters observed at site inspections listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

Application to vary a development standard

Following consideration of a written request from the applicant, made under cl 4.6 (3) of the Coffs Habour Local Environmental Plan 2013 (LEP), that has demonstrated that:

- a) compliance with cl. 4.3 (development standard) is unreasonable or unnecessary in the circumstances; and
- b) there are sufficient environmental planning grounds to justify contravening the development standard

the panel is satisfied that:

- a) the applicant's written request adequately addresses the matters required to be addressed under cl 4.6 (3) of the LEP; and
- b) the development is in the public interest because it is consistent with the objectives of cl. 4.3 (development standard) of the LEP and the objectives for development in the zone; and
- c) the concurrence of the Secretary has been assumed.

The panel notes the applicant's Clause 4.6 written request has misquoted the height measurements but that the Council's assessment correctly calculates the maximum height; the panel is satisfied the Clause 4.6 application satisfies the relevant objectives.

Development application

The panel determined to approve the development application pursuant to section 4.16 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The decision was 3:1 in favour, against the decision was Stephen Gow.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The panel determined to uphold the Clause 4.6 variation to building height; and approve the application for the reasons outlined in the council assessment report.

Stephen Gow disagreed with the majority decision for the following reasons:

Mr Gow noted the advice from Council concerning the numerical error in the applicant's submission pursuant to cl. 4.6 of the LEP. While supporting the proposal on merit, he was of the view that the submission should be corrected to reference the correct height variation being sought before the application is granted conditional consent.

CONDITIONS

The development application was approved subject to the conditions in the council assessment report.

CONSIDERATION OF COMMUNITY VIEWS

In coming to its decision, the panel notes that no written objections were made during public exhibition and therefore no issues of concern were raised.
