• 2019WCI001 - Liverpool City Council - DA-926/2018

25 George Street, Liverpool - Construction of a commercial tower and a new entertainment and leisure precinct (ELP) at the existing Westfield Shopping Centre. Proposal involves;

- o Demolition of a portion of existing shopping centre and southern façade fronting Elizabeth Drive;
- o Construction of an 8 storey commercial tower
- o Provision of approximately 5,992sqm of retail GFA over four retail levels inclusive of the following tenancies;
- Commercial Premises;
- Retail Premises
- Food and drink premises including restaurants and tavern;
- Entertainment Facilities
- Recreation facilities (indoor) including ancillary uses.
- o Landscaping works including a new entrance to the shopping centre at street level and a new landscaped public domain on levels 3 and 4.
