KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED

- All Panel members confirmed they have no conflict of interest
- Private waste facility, designated development
- Range of waste types, and processing proposed, including concrete crushing. The Panel noted the EPA
 has raised concern about some waste types, and this needs to be considered and addressed in
 Council's assessment
- Council's assessment needs to consider and address a number of issues, including:
 - vehicle queueing and interaction between different vehicle types, including vehicle storage while roller doors are closed during concrete crushing.
 - 24 hour operation, clarification of activities to be carried out at night/ early morning and impacts on any sensitive receptors
 - internal noise and impacts of workers during noisy operations and concurrent noisy activities
 - air quality, including cumulative impacts, using current data
 - ensuring there is a legal point of discharge for all stormwater
 - emergency vehicle access and turning path to the rear of the building
 - management procedures for monitoring incoming waste, and dealing with unauthorised waste, including asbestos
 - adequacy of proposed landscaping
