KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED

- The timeframes involved for the processing of the organic waste and physical location for the processing activities this is all undercover. The design has included capacity for overflow in peak times such as summer.
- Equipment involved in the process.
- The EIS and compliance with the SEARS.
- Traffic impacts access and operational traffic.
- Odour process operates under negative pressure and odour is at the forefront of the design. Closest receiver is 620m to the North. Sensitivity modelling has been completed.
- One submission of objection received from notification process.
- Community consultation drop in sessions held for the community and 1350 postcards sent out.
- Leachate system on the site.
- Demand for organic products at the end of the process.
- Environmental Protection Licence operating hours and truck deliveries.
