KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED

- Concerned about noncompliance with DCP
- Overshadowing on adjoining properties and facades. Diagrams cut off at Cottage Creek
- Lack of visual impact assessment
- Scope of public exhibition of DA and extent of notification
- Traffic impacts
- Wind impact on properties above ground level
- Verve is considered a benchmark of good architecture in the Newcastle CBD
- Potential for development to set a precedence

The Panel requested that Council to ensure that the above issues were addressed in its Supplementary Assessment Report.
