Introduction

- o Council is yet to undertake its full application assessment, so this record is not a final list of the issues they will need to consider in order to draft their recommendation.
- The application is yet to be considered by the Hunter & Central Coast Regional Planning Panel and therefore future comment will not be limited to the detail contained within.

Council summary

o Permissible of development within the zone

- Outline of the proposed development provided
- o Initial matters for consideration include access, traffic, parking and stormwater
- o Access issue raised in preliminary DA discussion but not addressed in application

Applicant introduction of proposal

- Proposal outlined, noting demand for school in Forster as large number of students travel daily to Taree
- Notation of propose future expansion indicated on plans with extended earth pad, with need to lease additional land to cater for future growth
- Surrounding residential development noted, with the availability of land in Forster being limited
- Grant funding received for the proposal
- RFI received in September, including updated stormwater modelling to include additional car parking and amendment to stormwater infrastructure
- o Further traffic impacts to consider, with options to stagger pick up times

Panel comments

- Traffic road safety operations and impacts on existing road systems to be assessed
- Adequate bicycle parking area to be provided
- Car parking (including pick up and drop off areas) to be provided onsite with minimal impact on adjoining development and road network
- Water quality across the site to be outlined
- TIA to be updated to include survey of afternoon parking in the area, clarification of source for the assumptions made and future use of the area
- o Stormwater management to be detailed
- Operational Management Plan to be provided, outlining the proposed management solutions
- o Future development is not considered as part of this application
- o Consideration of built form and interface within adjoining properties
