### **KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED**

- Council has just received a revised site layout plan which may address issues raised in relation to RFS, stormwater and relationship to the adjoining approved subdivision development to the north however Council has not had a chance to fully assess at this stage.
- Proposed new buildings are being moved off the northern boundary which could address RFS concerns, stormwater management and may not result in any tree removal.
- Council are expecting a full response and package of amended plans and documentation by June 30<sup>th</sup>.
- Amended documentation will need to be re-referred and Council will need to determine if reexhibition is required in accordance with Council's policies. No submissions were received in response to initial notification and amended proposal unlikely to create any additional impacts.
- RFI needs to fully respond to Council's request for detailed clarification of number of on-site car
  parking spaces and provide a comprehensive report addressing the cumulative impacts and
  competing demands of the various uses on the site with the school, early learning centre and
  church.

The Panel is supportive in principle of the amended site layout subject to Council completing its full assessment of the application. The Panel expects the applicant to work proactively with Council and supply the amended package of information by late June as advised. The Panel considers that the application will be able to proceed to determination unless Council raises any further issues.
