MATTER DEFERRED

PPSHCC-189 – Central Coast – DA/117/2023 – 63-69 Lake Road, Tuggerah 2259 – Resource Transfer Depot (as described in Schedule 1).

REASONS FOR DEFERRAL

The Panel considered the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at the meetings observed at the site inspection listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

The Panel has had the benefit of an initial briefing from Council and the Applicant. This application has been under assessment for some 18 months and has been recommended for refusal.

Arising from the final briefing from both Council and the Applicant, the Panel understands that there has been very little communication with the Applicant since the submission of their response to the RFI some six months ago. Furthermore, the Applicant was only notified of the Panel's meeting one day before the meeting and had not had the opportunity to review the report.

The Council assessment report raises concerns with several matters which the Applicant needs to address. Stormwater management and water quality are fundamental issues with the application. There also needs to be sufficient information to satisfy the jurisdictional preconditions.

The Panel considers that, in the circumstances of this application, the Applicant should be given the opportunity to review the report and respond to the issues raised.

To this end, the Panel agrees to defer the determination of the matter to allow the Applicant to respond to the Council assessment report.

The Panel also requires the relevant Council officers to meet with the Applicant to ensure a clear understanding of the issues.

The Panel agreed to defer the determination of the matter.

The decision to defer the matter was unanimous.

ACTIONS

The determination of the Development Application be deferred for the following:

- 1. Council is to meet with the Applicant to provide clear advice as to what is needed.
- 2. The Applicant to provide sufficient information to address the matters identified in the Council assessment report.

- 3. A formal written request to amend the application is required to be uploaded to Planning Portal by the Applicant by 30 January 2025, outlining:
 - a. Particulars sufficient to indicate the nature of the change of the development, as required under section 37 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Regulation 2021.
 - b. updated technical reports relied on in the amended application.
- 4. Council is requested to provide an addendum assessment report responding to the matters above, which is to be uploaded to the Planning Portal within three (3) weeks of the upload of the Applicants required information to the Planning Portal.
- 5. When the updated assessment report is received, the Panel will determine the application by way of electronic determination.

If the outstanding information is not provided, the Panel may move to determine the DA based on the information currently at hand.
