## See responses below:

1. At maximum tracking system tilt, the solar panels are expected to be ~2.3 m high.

- 2. The spacing between solar panels when in the horizontal position will be 3 4 m which should be sufficient distance for grazing. Note that the spacing between the tracking system centre-lines will be around 5 6 m.
- 3. See attached 80219037-CI-Combined-Issued for DA Approval.pdf for plans showing the set-back of the solar farm. There will be ~100 m set-back from the highway at the nearest point and ~25 m from the railway line to the south. The solar farm will be set-back by an at least 10 m asset protection zone from its western boundary. Note that the land east of the solar farm boundary is owned by the proponent.
