KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED

- Status update briefing.
- Following the briefings in January and May 2024 the Panel is now in receipt of advice that confirms the approach to biodiversity as set out in paragraphs 173 and 174 of Planners North v Ballina in relation to avoidance and mitigation.
- The Panel understands that Council is seeking their own advice.
- The Panel notes that Council advises that they have worked with the applicant regarding further avoidance. A reduced footprint is now being proposed.
- Panel are seeking a way forward but need to make sure that they can deal with the application legally.
- Panel will need details of the nature of the vegetation that is being avoided in the Councils assessment.
- The Panel reiterates the matters raised in the previous briefings.

The Panel note that the matter is scheduled for determination in early October.
