Sanitary Depot for the Disposal of
Garbage at South Way Woy.

1. The Minister for Health, on the advice of the Health Commission of New South Wales and in accordance with the provisions of Section 263 (4) of the Local Government Act, 1919 has approved of the area described hereunder for use as a sanitary depot for the disposal of garbage at South Way Woy, subject to the following conditions:

- 1.1 Construct a suitable all weather access road to the site.
- 1.2 Construct and maintain suitable drains to prevent run-off from the adjoining hills reaching the garbage area.
- 1.3 Pipe and also protect the pipes, or divert, the watercourse which traverses the intended site to prevent leachings from entering the watercourse and safeguard the watercourse from pollution at all times.
- 1.4 The tipping area to be divided into sections of suitable and easily controlled size and each section developed as a separate cell.
- 1.5 Garbage must not be tipped directly into water. Where water is present it must be filled with hard fill to above water level, prior to deposit of garbage.
- 1.6 Depot rubbish to be disposed of on compacted layers not exceeding 1.8 metres in depth. Car bodies or other large items of refuse should be completely flattened before disposal.
- 1.7 All depot rubbish deposited on the area to be covered with at least 15 cm. of soil or other suitable material on completion of each days tipping.

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- 1.8 All depot rubbish to be confined to the working area and the face kept as short as possible.
- 1.9 The finished surface of the fill is to be not less than 0.4 metres of compacted soil or clay, graded to shed stormwater and prevent surface ponding.
- 1.10 Adequate suitable earth moving equipment is to be maintained at the depot to compact and cover the garbage upon deposit.
- 1.11 An attendant to be present at the depot at all times it is open to the public.
- 1.12 Enclosure of the disposal area with a 1.8 metre high wire mesh fence and provision of lock up gates at the entrance to exclude unauthorised persons from the area during the periods when the depot is unattended.
- 1.13 No scavenging to be permitted on the depot.
- 1.14 Effective fly, cockroach and vermin control measures are carried out at the depot.
- 1.15 Burning of combustible material to be prohibited and should fire occur, prompt action taken to extinguish it at all times. An adequate water supply and fire fighting equipment to be provided for this purpose.
- 1.16 Systematic grading and filling of the filled area to be carried out.
- 1.17 Any discharge of effluent or surface water from the site will be subject to the Clean Waters Act and will be required to be regulated under that Act.
- 1.18 Description

All that parcel of land containing 16.56 hectares or thereabouts, situated near Woy Woy, Parish of Patonga Shire of Gosford, County of Northumberland and State of New South Wales, being also part of land in File Plan 184947 and Portion 171 and 170 and in the possession of Gosford Shire Council.

Commencing at a point 250m north of the southwest corner of Lot 1 in F.P. 184947 and thence bounded on the north by a

line 90° 240 metres thence on the east by a line 180° 690 metres thence on the south by a line 270° and 240 metres to the eastern boundary of Brisbane Water National Park aforesaid thence on the west by that eastern boundary 0 degrees 690 metres to the point of commencement excluding the site of the Crown Reserve road shown on Plan portion 171, being part portion 110, 171 and part lot 1 file plan 184947 also being part of the land in Certificates of Title Volume 5033 Folio 72 and Volume 11967 folio 215.
