- Four (4) submissions received

- Setbacks from the adjoining residential lots noted
- Relationship to reserve
- Additional clarification required to determine the hardstand and landscaping on riparian corridor edge
- Need to avoid a hard edge to riparian corridor and understand boundary conditions including any retaining walls and impact on vegetation
- Appropriateness of emergency access point further detail is required to determine whether this is an appropriate width. Needs to be relocated further away from 44 Stronach Avenue
- Consider landscaping interface with 6 Martin Close and location of pathways
- Amenity for occupants has been well considered
