**PPSHCC-7 – Cessnock – 8/2019/568/1** - 8 Styles St, Kurri Kurri - Expansion of an existing waste management facility (resource recovery facility) to increase processing capacity to 90,000 tonnes on non-putrescible waste, including the processing of 400 tonnes/day, operating hours extended to 24 hours per day, stockpile height increased to maximum 6m on site and a storage capacity of 30,000 tonnes at any one time
