PPSHCC-80 – Lake Macquarie – DA/202/2016/A - 64, 66, 68, 70 and 72 Warners Bay Road, Warners Bay - Modification of approved residential aged care facility – change of building design and reduction in beds.

KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED

- The Council issued a detailed RFI in July and a response has now been received.
- Plans have been provided to address whether the development is substantially the same and Council now needs to complete its detail assessment of this.
- Zoning and permissibility questions have been addressed.
- Further details have been provided in respect of landscaping, fencing, flood planning constraints, acoustics, visuals and building heights.
- Council should detail what was previously approved and compare to what is now proposed so it is clear for the Panel.
- The Panel specifically wants to understand any changes to the boundaries this includes the side driveway, acoustic fencing / treatments.

- Tree removal needs to be specifically dealt with and assessed, particularly where any additional tree removal / impacts are proposed and why trees on the boundaries need to be removed (trees 23, 24, 35 and 26 specifically).
- The Panel questioned the flood refuge area and how this would work.
- The Council assessment report needs to ensure that any previous conditions imposed by the Panel are addressed.
- Detailed cross sections are required to demonstrate boundary impacts particularly for the driveway interface and the Panel expects a good landscaping amenity on this boundary.
- The assessment report needs to include a description of how the consent is to be modified and which conditions are to be modified / deleted and/or replaced.
- A track changes version of the conditions is required to assist the Panel in its determination of the application.
