## **KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED**

- Original application history and determination outcome
- Review application proposal, noting it includes subdivision and seniors housing components
- Site suitability issues for residential aged care facility, including flooding,
- Internal referrals undertaken, with some comments outstanding
- Consultation with TfNSW in relation to infrastructure works in the road reserve and implications of other agency requirements – comments yet to be received
- Bushfire prone land and RFS requirement for emergency access to the highway
- Adequacy and consistency between documentation, in particular proposed tree removal, vegetation maintenance, relationship to servicing plans, site contamination/location of fill, and variation to height

- Location of sewer main and implications of relocation required to cater for identified road widening and impact on neighbouring properties
