KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED

- Overview of proposed development including seniors housing development in conjunction with existing club facility and car park
- Compliance with height of buildings and floor space ratio for the combined site, with no variations proposed
- Request for Further Information has been sent
- Key Issues include:
 - o Wayfinding, building access points and location of lift cores/building separation identification
 - SEPP65 compliance issues solar access and building orientation, separation and privacy, overshadowing, communal and private open space dimensions, engineering, noting that the density is creating amenity issues (acoustic and visual privacy)
 - Acceptability of the interface with the adjoining car park
 - Noise assessment to be reviewed to consider location of car park and roller door near bedrooms and ability to leave windows open whilst maintaining noise compliance
 - Light spill from car park into below ground level units
 - Additional design details required to adequately address solar access (including balcony balustrading/screening)
 - o Waste services location, access on site and adequacy for development
