KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED

- Development permissible under Schedule 1 Additional Permitted Uses of the 2012 LEP (with same provision to be included in draft LEP)
- Area has been master-planned as a new air-side business park with the museum building a major component (generating tourism)
- Site constraints include noise from the New England Highway and Airport
- New England Highway elevation has been designed to incorporate articulation and colour changes
- Landscaping buffer (6m wide) along highway frontage maintained by Council
- Referral to Essential Energy is outstanding, noting development to be located outside of easement
- Noise sensitivity design should include some noise reduction, noting the POEO Act requirements and the existing air services located in close proximity to the site.
- Car parking confirmation of calculation method to be provided in the assessment report. Comparison
 of traffic generation/parking provisions of similar operations in other localities may be useful in
 determining adequacy of proposal.
- RV parking to be provided in the street, with Local Traffic Committee approval being sort.
- Referral to Airport Manager in regard to lighting assessment report to confirm that the lighting will
 meet the requirements
- Development is below the maximum height identified on the Obstacle Surface Limitation mapping
- No submissions received
