OBSERVATIONS

- Site and site context from Horizon Drive and River Street
- Proposed site for new building, linkage to existing building, buildings to be demolished and trees to be removed
- General location of new buildings proposed under long term masterplan such as 550 seat theatre, new parking and entry arrangements, temporary demountable buildings
- Riverbend Drive area where current informal parking to be formalised

DISCUSSION

• Current student and staff populations (800 students and 100 staff) and future populations (1,100 students and 150 staff). Current approval (1996 = 800 students)

- Traffic and parking arrangements potential queuing on River Street to enter Horizon Drive; formalisation of parking on Riverbend Drive; student bus services; outstanding Transport for NSW (TfNSW) Request for Information
- 4 flood conditions overland flow, riverine, tidal, intense localised rainfall. Overland flow considered most significant
- Tree removal
- Ground conditions and differential settlement silt and fill requiring separation of buildings
- All RFIs complete except TfNSW
- 2030 Masterplan to be provided to Panel
- Statement of Environmental Effects based on cumulative assessment of Masterplan
