MATTER DEFERRED

PPSNTH-189 – Port Macquarie-Hastings – DA2022 - 901.1 – 86-94 Lake Road PORT MACQUARIE NSW 2444 – Alterations and Additions to Hospital (as described in Schedule 1).

REASONS FOR DEFERRAL

The panel agreed to defer the determination of the matter until the following information has been provided to address the concerns raised by the Panel:

- Confirmation of on-site car parking requirements for each stage and analysis to justify the proposed number and location of spaces, including during construction.
- Draft Construction Management Plan, including the proposed staging and separation of work zones and operational elements of the hospital and adjoining development
- Clarification of proposed final staff and consultant numbers
- Landscaping treatment generally, but particularly along the southern boundary, Lake Road and Parker Street and car parks

The Panel expects the revised information as referred to above, be submitted to Council within 2 months from the date of this deferral record. Council is requested to assess the information provided and provide a supplementary assessment report within a maximum of 6 weeks of the receipt of the revised information (allowing for any further community consultation, if deemed necessary by Council).

If the revised information from the applicant is not provided within 3 months, the Panel may move to determine the DA based on the information currently at hand. Should this occur, the Council is requested to confirm their recommendation, with any recommendation for partial approval to be outlined in a supplementary assessment report.

When this information has been received, the Panel will determine the matter electronically.

The decision to defer the matter was unanimous.
